


All buffets include Fresh Brewed Tea, Lemonade and Dessert. A 9% sales tax and a 15% gratuity will be added to all buffets

#### **Tournament Timeline**

- Once a date is decided, a \$200 deposit is required to reserve the date. The deposit will be applied & deducted from the final invoice.
- If a deposit is not made, the course reserves the right to allow I week notice before using the date for another event.
- After deposit is made, the Gauntlet will post on their events calendar page on www.golfgauntlet.com
- One week prior, Gauntlet will receive final head count for food purchase.
- Three days prior final group pairing list in required format.
- Final payment is due one week after event if not paid on site after the event.

#### 19th Bar And Grille

The 19th Hole Bar & Grille will be 1 hour prior to event registration, as well as after events for food & beverage purchases.

# **Sponsorship Opportunities**

### Raffles, Mulligans and More

Organizing a raffle during a golf tournament is an excellent strategy to encourage sign-ups and donations while also engaging non-golfing attendees. Raffle prizes provide a fantastic opportunity to secure donations from sponsors. Consider reaching out to local restaurants and businesses for gift cards. Additionally, items like cigar boxes and bottles of wine make for great raffle prizes. Other appealing options include complimentary rounds of golf at the host course or a premium set of clubs. Since many golfers are also sports enthusiasts, signed memorabilia or tickets to games would be ideal for attendees. In addition to Raffles and Mulligans, the Gauntlet can offer on course opportunities to raise donations with fun interactive games. Make sure to ask your coordinator for on course activities to enhance your players experience and raise additional funds. To increase the contributions, many tournaments allow players to purchase a mulligan to be used for different mulligan packages.

#### Examples of Mulligans include:

- A Musket Ball / or Throw to continue the shot
- Extra Putt on the Green
- Move forward a tee box
- String to extend a shot
- Mulligans (2nd Shot)

A Mulligan package all goes directly towards the event. This is a great and quick way to raise extra funds for the charity.
